Qādiyānism - The Falsehood

My brothers and sisters. Allāh ﷻ has clearly stated in the Holy Qur'ān, "Muhammad is not the father of any man amongst you, but he is the **Messenger of Allāh and the Seal of all the Prophets**, and Allāh is aware of all things." (33:40)

All commentators of the Holy Qur'ān have said that this verse is clear proof that our Holy Prophet ﷺ is **the last of all the prophets ﷺ and that there shall be no prophet after him.**

In the two most authentic books of Ahādeeth, (Bukhāri and Muslim), it is written: Sayyiduna Jubair Ibn Muth'im ؓ reports that he heard the Holy Prophet ﷺ saying, "Certainly there are some names for me. I am Muhammad, I am Ahmad, I am Māhi the obliterator as Allāh ﷻ shall put out Kufr through me, I am Hāshir the gatherer of people who shall be resurrected at my feet and I am Āqib **the last to come as there shall be no prophet after me.**" (Bukhāri, Muslim)

Sayyiduna Abu Hurairah ؓ relates that the Holy Prophet ﷺ said, "Banu Isrā'eel were led by their own prophets. When one prophet died another prophet took his place, **but there shall be no prophet after me.** However there shall be caliphs and they shall be many."
(Bukhāri, Muslim)

Sayyiduna Abu Hurairah ؓ reported that the Holy Prophet ﷺ said, "Certainly my example and the example of the prophets before me is like the example of a palace elegant and most beautifully constructed by a person except that he left a blank space for a brick in one of its corners and that made the people who were going around it wonder at its excellence and exclaimed in bewilderment, "Why hasn't this brick been laid here?" The Holy Prophet ﷺ said, "I am that (corner's last) brick and

I am the last of the prophets.” (Bukhāri, Muslim)

How truthful the Holy Prophet ﷺ was when he stated, “In my Ummah thirty liars will be born, each will claim prophethood and pretend to be a prophet, though **I am the last of the prophets and there shall be no prophet after me.**” (Abu Dāwood)

According to this prophecy many liars claiming to be the prophet have already appeared and will keep on appearing until the last to appear will be the Dajjāl.

From these many liars, Mirza Ghulām Ahmad Qādiyāni is one of them who claimed many things in his life time.

1) He claimed to be Allāh ﷻ and the creator of the Heavens and the Earth. He has written: “I saw in my dream that I AM ALLĀH and I believed, no doubt I am the one who created the Heavens.” (Aaina-e-kamālāt)

2) He claimed to be nine prophets. He said, “I am Ādam, I am Nuh (Noah), I am Ibrāhim (Abraham), I am Ishāq (Isaac), I am Yaqoob (Jacob), I am Ismāeel (Ishmael), I am Moosa (Moses), I am Eesa (Jesus) and I am Muhammad.” (Roohāni Khazāin)

3) He claimed to be the mother of Sayyiduna Eesa ﷺ and then he claimed to be the Holy Prophet Eesa ﷺ himself. He said that first God converted him into Maryam (Mary). After two years, God made him pregnant by blowing the soul of Sayyiduna Eesa ﷺ into him, he remained pregnant for ten months, after which God converted him into Sayyiduna Eesa ﷺ. This is how he became Sayyiduna Eesa’s ﷺ mother and Sayyiduna Eesa ﷺ. (Roohāni Khazāin)

4) He claimed that he is Muhammad the Messenger of Allāh ﷻ. “Muhammad is the Messenger of Allāh, and those with him are hard against the disbelievers and mer-

ciful amongst themselves. He says that in this divine revelation he has been named Muhammad and also Rasool." (Roohāni Khazāin, Page 207, Vol. 18)

5) He claimed to be the Mahdi and the Promised Messiah though he did not fulfill the conditions laid by the Holy Prophet ﷺ regarding the Mahdi and the Promised Messiah.

6) He claimed to be Krishna (Hindu god) in 1904.

Furthermore Mirza Ghulām Ahmad Qādiyāni;

a) Dishonours Allāh ﷻ, the Creator. He says in his infamous book Roohāni Khazāin, Page 39, Vol. 20: "Where can the humans escape from That Being Whose Hands is every atom." He says, "I will come secretly like thieves."

b) Debases the greatest of all prophets, the Holy Prophet Muhammad ﷺ. He claimed that Holy Prophet ﷺ and his Sahābah (Companions) used to eat cheese made by the Christians, although it was well known that pig's fat was used in its making.

(Newspaper-Al-Fadhl, Qādiyān 22nd February 1924).

c) Believes that Islām is incomplete without belief in Mirza Ghulām Ahmad Qādiyāni.

d) Believes that the words of his are equal to the Holy Qur'ān.

e) Declares all non-Qādiyānis as non-Muslims.

So according to Mirza Ghulām Ahmad Qādiyāni, you and I and one billion Muslims are Kāfirs (non-Muslims). He stated that one who recited the Kalimah of Muhammad of Arabia was a Kāfir. (Kalimatul-Fasl)

In another place he says, "Allāh has made it clear to me that every person whom my call has reached and has not accepted me is not a Muslim." (Tazkirah, Page 600)

That makes you and I Kāfir as we have recited the Kalimah of the Holy Prophet Muhammad ﷺ and have rejected Mirza Ghulām Ahmad Qādiyāni's call.

I am sure by now you have come to the conclusion that Mirza Ghulām Ahmad Qādiyāni was not a prophet but the greatest **DECEIVER** to the religion of Islām, who died in a toilet from a disease called cholera while vomiting and discharging faeces from both ends of his gastro-intestinal system on 26th May 1908.

His followers whether called Qādiyānis, Ahmadis or Mirzāis, are **NOT** Muslims but Kāfirs (non-Muslims) and are equally...
