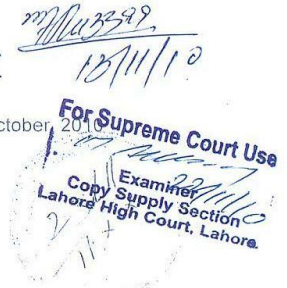

Respectfully Sheweth:

It is humbly submitted that the Petitioner, Mr. Bashir Ahmed Khan, sent the letter to Secretary National Assembly on 07.06.2010 under the direction of the Hon' able Lahore High Court, Lahore which was received in the National Assembly Secretariat on 11.06.2010 and in the office of Secretary National Assembly Secretariat on 12.06.2010. In compliance with the Hon' able Court's direction, the Secretary forwarded the order with the observation " please process it urgently ".

2. The Secretariat started the implementation process with all possible agility. Since the proceedings and the report of the Special Committee of the whole House were declared secret, therefore, first of all, the approval of Hon' able Madam Speaker was sought under the Rules of Procedure and Conduct of Business in the National Assembly, 2007 for the declassification of record and distribution of its copies on demand. The Hon, able Madam Speaker graciously accorded the approval on 21.06.2010. Soon after obtaining approval of the Competent Authority, the process of sorting out of this voluminous record was carried out and then the relevant material was handed over to the Proof Readers of the National Assembly for conducting the work of proof reading as per the requirement of the Printing Corporation of Pakistan.

3. All the above essential requirements were completed in the face of Budget Session which happens to be the heaviest Session with regard to work load and finally, the same material was sent to the Printing Corporation of Pakistan in a consolidated and composed form for the purpose of printing on 30.07.2010.

4. The printing Corporation of Pakistan demanded the cost of *printing* of these Debates Rs. 40, 40,000/- (Rupees Forty Lac Forty Thousand only) in the first phase of printing of 16 Debates and in the second phase, for the printing of other 5 Debates, Rs. 6,78,000/- (Rupees Six Lac Seventy Eight Thousand only).

5. The National Assembly issued Sanction of the 75% of the total cost in advance as per demand of the Printing Corporation of Pakistan after getting approval of the Competent Authority. Further, it was asked from the Printing Corporation of Pakistan to intimate this Secretariat that how much time, it will require for composing, reading and final printing of these Debates.

6. The Printing Corporation of Pakistan intimated this Secretariat on 25.08.2010 that the time schedule for composing and printing of 16 Debates will be about four to six months from the date of receipt of advance payment and clearance of proof by the National Assembly Secretariat.

7. Therefore, it is submitted that in compliance with the Hon' able Court's direction, the National Assembly Secretariat is pursuing the matter on urgent basis and is going to spend Rs. 47,18,000/-, (Forty Seven Lac Eighteen Thousand) and has sanctioned 75% of the total amount in advance. Since the enormous record of the Proceedings of the Special Committee of the Whole House and the report thereon is in the printing phase, therefore, it is assured that the same will be provided to the Petitioner after its printing.

8. Accordingly, the answering respondent has not committed any contempt of court. Hence, in view of the above, the instant petition may very kindly be dismissed.
