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Has the Messiah Come ?

In 2018, the Qadiani group in United Kingdom launched an advertising campaign, displaying the message: "The Messiah has come", alongside the picture of Mirza Ghulam Ahmad Qadiani on billboards in some cities and along certain motorways. The whole purpose of this campaign was to preach to the public that the Messiah has come, and thus people must obey him and become part of the Qadiani group. However, the question here is that has the Messiah really arrived? The Muslim answer to this is: Yes, a Messiah has surely come, but not the true Messiah, rather it is only a counterfeit Messiah that has appeared. Mirza Ghulam Ahmad Qadiani's Claim: "I am the same Promised Messiah whose advent was mentioned by the Messenger of Allah (sallallahu alayhi wasallam) in the authentic narrations which are recorded in Sahih Bukhari, Sahih Muslim and other books. " (Malfoozat, Vol 1, pg. 327).

This claim is false, deceptive and fraudulent. Mirza Ghulam Ahmad Qadiani is most certainly not the Messiah who was foretold to come by the Prophet (sallallahu alayhi wasallam).

Who is the True Messiah ?

The Prophet (sallallahu alayhi wasallam) stated the name of the True Messiah to be Isa (Jesus) son of Maryam (Mary), who was created by Allah without a father and was appointed as a prophet for the Children of Israel. Allah revealed the Injil to him. When the enemies conspired to crucify him on the cross, Allah saved him by physically raising him alive, with his body, to the heavens. He is still physically alive in the heavens. The Quran and the Sunnah mention Isa (alayhis salam) as either Isa son of Maryam, or the Messiah son of Maryam, or the son of Maryam. In the Quran, Allah declared Isa (alayhis salam) son of Maryam as a sign of the End Times (Qur'an, 43:61). When the Antichrist (Dajjal) will appear in the world, Isa (alayhis salam) will descend from the heavens to destroy him. There are more than a hundred narrations of the Prophet (sallallahu alayhi wasallam) reported by more than thirty Companions about the descent of Isa (alayhis salam) to this world, and among those narrations more than forty are through uninterrupted transmission (mutawatir).

The Prophet (sallallahu alayhi wasallam) has amazingly described full details about Isa (alayhis salam), i.e., the signs preceding his descent, his physical appearance and facial features, the political landscape at the time of his descent, his achievements and so forth. Among all these narrations only one is being presented here; Abu Hurairah (radhiallahu anhu) narrated that the Prophet (sallallahu alayhi wasallam) said: "The Prophets are paternal brothers; their mothers are different but their religion is one. I am the closest of the people to Isa son of Maryam, because there is no other prophet between him and myself. He is going to descend amongst you, and when you see him, you will recognise him. He will be of medium height and of reddish-white complexion. He will be wearing two yellow garments, and his hair will be as though it is dripping with water. He will break the cross, kill the swine, abolish the jizyah and call people to Islam. During his time, Allah will end all religions besides Islam, and will destroy the Dajjal in his era. Then peace will prevail on earth, such that lions will graze with camels, tigers with cattle, and wolves with sheep; children will play with snakes without being harmed by them. He will remain for forty years, then die, and the Muslims will offer his funeral prayer.

" (Abu Dawud, Vol 2 pg 135, Musnad Ahmad, Vol 2 pg 406)

This abovementioned narration is authentic. The second Qadiani deputy (khalifa) Mirza Mahmood has also mentioned this hadith in his book Haqeeqat al-Nubuwwah (pg 192), and it is from there that we have cited the hadith.

The details about Isa (alayhis salam) and the era of his descent as mentioned by the Prophet (sallallahu alayhi wasallam) in this hadith are as follows:

- 1.The one who will descend is the Son of Maryam; he cannot be the son of Chiragh Bibi.
 - 2.The name of the Messiah who will descend is Isa (alayhis salam), not Mirza Ghulam Ahmad.
 - 3.The name of the Messiah's mother is Maryam the Truthful (as-siddiqah). She is not Chiragh Bibi.
 - 4.All other religions will perish in the era of descent of Isa (alayhis salam).
 - 5.In the era of Isa (alayhis salam), such peace will prevail that lions will graze alongside camels, cheetahs with cows, and wolves with goats, and children will play with snakes.
- Now let us analyse if the era of Mirza Ghulam Ahmad Qadiani, the self-proclaimed Messiah, concord with what the Prophet (sallallahu alayhi wasallam) described in the authentic narrations. Was this the global situation existent during the era of Mirza Ghulam Ahmad Qadiani? Did all religions perish, leaving only Islam to prevail? Let alone other religions, the Qadiani group itself was torn into fourteen factions. After the descent of the real Messiah, no two wild animals will be fight, let alone two men fighting. All wars will come to an end. However, since the advent of Mirza Ghulam Ahmad Qadiani, two world wars have occurred and the third world war is on the verge of happening. A cursory glance at world affairs shows how many humans are being killed all around the world on a daily basis. The only conclusion we can draw from all of this is that Mirza Ghulam Ahmad Qadiani can never be the Messiah foretold by our Prophet (sallallahu alayhi wasallam).

Denial of Mirza Ghulam Ahmad Qadiani of being Messiah.

"O my brothers in faith and scholars of the firm religion! Listen very attentively to the thoughts I am offering: the claim of this humble one of being the likeness of the Promised Messiah, which is being misunderstood as the Promised Messiah by some foolish people, is not a new claim uttered by myself just today. This is the same old inspiration which I received from God Almighty and clearly recorded in Barahin-e- Ahmadiyyah in several places, which has been published more than seven years ago. I never claimed that I am the Messiah, Son of Mary. Anybody who accuses me of this is an extreme fabricator and liar. In fact, it is continuously being published since seven or eight years from my side that I am the likeness of the Messiah.

" (Izaala-i-Awhaam, Roohani Khazaain, Vol 3, page 192).

The essence of the above reflections of Mirza Ghulam Ahmad Qadiani is without a doubt that the Messiah which has been promised to come is the Messiah, the Son of Maryam, and since Mirza Ghulam Ahmad Qadiani, by his own admission, is not the Messiah, the Son of Maryam, Mirza Ghulam Ahmad Qadiani cannot be the Promised Messiah. In fact, any person who believes that Mirza Ghulam Ahmad Qadiani is the Messiah, the Son of Maryam, or the Promised Messiah, such a person is a fabricator and a liar.

Neither Muslims nor Christians believe in an Indian Messiah!

How Mirza Ghulam Ahmad Qadiani turned into the Son of Mary

So, although God referred to me as Mary in the third part of Barahin-e-Ahmadiyyah, and as is evident from the treatise itself, for two years I was nurtured in the likeness of Mary and continued to develop in the cloak of secrecy. Then after two years had passed, as it is recorded in the fourth part of Barahin-e-Ahmadiyyah on page 496, like Mary, the soul of Jesus was breathed into me, and in metaphorical terms, I was impregnated

Then, after a period of no more than ten months, through the revelation recorded towards the end of the fourth part of Barahin-e-Ahmadiyya on page 556, from Mary I was transformed into Jesus. And thus, I became the Son of Mary. (Noah's Ark (Kashti-i-Nuh), pg. 81).

The signs of the Messiah as mentioned by the Prophet (sallallahu alayhi wasallam) were not found in Mirza Ghulam Ahmad Qadiani. The most amazing fact is that just as Mirza Ghulam Ahmad Qadiani cannot be the true Messiah in light of the sayings of the Prophet (sallallahu alayhi wasallam), Mirza Ghulam Ahmad Qadiani cannot be the Messiah even according to his own statement. Hereunder are three of Mirza Ghulam Ahmad Qadiani's claims which we shall analyse:

(1)"The individuals who have been sent by God Almighty have many hundreds of signs to prove their truthfulness. They realise the end objective of their advent and they do not die until the purpose of their advent is not manifest. For those in search of truth, I apprise them that my mission for which I am standing here is to break the pillars of Christianity and to preach the oneness of Allah (tawheed) instead of the trinity, and to glorify and exalt the Prophet (sallallahu alayhi wasallam) in front of the world. Hence, even if millions of signs (of being the Messiah) manifest from me but this end objective is not achieved, I am a false claimant. So why has the world then turned against me? Why do they not look at my outcome? If in the defence of Islam, I accomplish that which was assigned to the Promised Messiah and the Promised Mahdi, I am truthful. If nothing is accomplished and I die, then all of you should bear witness that I am a liar. Ghulam Ahmad" (Maktoobat-i-Ahmad Jadeed, Vol 1 pg 498, Maktoob No. 29).

Please carefully analyse the above letter of Mirza Qadiani. He had to accomplish two tasks before dying: firstly, he had to break the pillars of Christianity, and secondly, he had to spread tawheed instead of the trinity. The valid question that arises is that did Mirza Ghulam Ahmad Qadiani succeed in accomplishing these missions? Let alone breaking the pillars of Christianity, according to the Qadiani periodical, Al Fazl, Qadian, 19 June 1941, in India 224 people of different religions were converting to Christianity on a daily basis. The state of Christianity flourishing globally will then definitely be well known to the Qadiani group. Therefore, it is evident that Mirza Ghulam Ahmad Qadiani's claim to being the Messiah is false. He is definitely not the true Messiah, but rather a counterfeit and fake Messiah.

(2)"Thus, if within these seven years no substantial effect of my service for Islam, through the help of God Almighty, appears; as is necessary for false religions to come to end at the hands of the Messiah, if the death of false religions does not occur through me, i.e., God Almighty does not manifest upon my hands that sign through which Islam is elevated and through which people from all sides begin to embrace Islam, and the false god of Christianity is destroyed and the world does not change; I swear by God Almighty that I will consider myself to be a liar."

(Anjam-i-Atham, Roohani Khazain, vol 11 pg 314-319).

Anjam-i-Atham was published in 1896. Mirza Ghulam Ahmad Qadiani had until 1903 to accomplish all these tasks, and he had sworn an oath to consider himself a liar if he failed to accomplish these tasks within this timeframe. Mirza Ghulam Ahmad Qadiani lived for twelve years after this statement and he had vowed to complete the above tasks within seven years. Let alone seven years, not a single one of these things was realised in his last twelve years. Hence, according to his own claim, what is Mirza Ghulam Ahmad Qadiani proven to be? Is he a liar or not?.
